Audit Item	Instructions	Your Answer
Alcohol-Based Hand Rub Availability	Is sanitizer within arm's reach of the patient/client? If staff have to walk to a wall unit, compliance drops significantly.	☐ Yes ☐ No
Reliability	Are more than 10% of your dispensers empty or broken? Empty dispensers signal to staff that hygiene isn't a priority.	☐ Yes ☐ No
Product Quality	Is the provided soap or sanitizer causing "tackiness" or irritation? Comfort is the #1 driver of long-term compliance.	☐ Yes ☐ No
Signage Placement	Use "Nudge Theory" by placing high-contrast signs at eye-level in transition zones. This triggers the habit of hand hygiene at the subconscious level, exactly when it's needed most.	☐ Yes ☐ No
